Bring your bike to one of our drop-in **Bike Doctor** events for a free safety check and minor repairs. Look out for the Bike Doctor sign and gazebo.

After the Bike Doctor events, join us for a **leisurely guided ride** to help build your cycling confidence and improve your wellbeing. Ideal for new and novice cyclists. Riders can bring their own helmets and roadworthy bikes, but both can be borrowed for free including disability cycles. <a href="Pre-booking">Pre-booking</a> is essential for the rides and spaces are limited to up to 6 people per ride. Ages 18+ only. Rides up to 1 hour. Book your guided ride place through <a href="Eventbrite">Eventbrite</a>.
