1 KOM Xeno rear hub £550+

The most interesting derailleur hub I've seen, the Xeno should be super strong and stiff. It has an oversized centre axle, with the bearings nearer load points, and a hub-length freehub axle. k-o-m.co.uk

2 Garmin Edge 1050 £649.99

Garmin's latest GPS computer has a lovely bright screen, a speaker and a slew of extra features, notably to GroupRide, but it's also expensive and lacks solar charging. garmin.com

3 Quoc X Restrap Sandal £89.99

Post-ride wear for bikepackers, these sandals'

webbing straps fasten together to secure them either side of a seatpack. Cycling UK members get 10% off. restrap.com

4 Bastille folding bike €2,590+

Available imminently (in France), this 27.5in-wheel (ISO 584) urban bike folds in 10 seconds to a claimed 92x73x33cm. It weighs 15kg but can be rolled on its wheels. bastillecycles.com

5 Muc-Off Valve Core Remover £7

Removing valve cores is inevitable with tubeless – to add sealant, blast in air to seat the tyre or to replace a clogged valve. This works for presta and schrader. muc-off.com

6 Pirelli P Zero TLR RS £86.99

Continental has a tyre made from dandelions, now Pirelli's top-end race tyre uses FSC-certified rubber. It's another step towards tyre sustainability. pirelli.com

7 Fumpa Gauge £35

At 30g, this USB-rechargeable gauge for tyres and air shocks is small enough for pressure tweakers to take along on a ride. Presta or schrader, max 250psi. fumpapumps.co.uk
